Training Hours	100 hours of emergency management AND 75 hours of general management. Training must be within the last 10 years. A maximum of 25 hours will be granted for any one course, except for the Advanced Professional Series which will satisfy all 100 hours of emergency management training. No more than 50% of all hours may be from online courses. The FEMA EMI Professional Development Series must be included in the training hours.	100 hours of emergency management AND 50 hours of general management. Training must be within the last 10 years. A maximum of 25 hours will be granted for any one course, except for the Advanced Professional Series which will satisfy all 100 hours of emergency management training. No more than 50% of all hours may be from online courses. The FEMA EMI Professional Development Series must be included in the training hours.
