

Bi-monthly Training and Exercise VESTEX & VOPEX




### March 16, 2020 – July 31, 2020


# **COVID-19 Pandemic in Virginia**

# Ratio to Rate for White Population Cumulative through April 22



✓ Implementation of COVIDWISE Verification Portal

- Language skills and demographics data is as of 5/31/21. Of the applicants surveyed, 30% did not provide demographic information. Of the Cl/CT applicants surveyed, 6.9% are Non-White (American Indian, Asian & Asian American, and Two or more races).
- 2. Box-It-In metrics include data aggregated between 9/4/20 5/26/21. Arlington and Fairfax data is not fully available.

## **Community Mitigation in Action**

- Most Executive Order restrictions lifted when EO79 went into effect on May 28
  - Community Mitigation Team released new guidance on May 28 to assist businesses with mitigation decision-making
  - VDH continues to advise a wide range of industries and settings (schools, faith-based orgs, courts, etc)
- Updated VDH EO complaint portal to reflect EO79 changes, and link will remain active through June 30




# Mask Recommendations

- CDC now recommends that anyone who is fully vaccinated can participate in indoor and outdoor activities without wearing a mask and without distancing in most settings
- Exceptions include K-12 public and private schools, public transit, healthcare facilities, homeless shelters, and correctional facilities






### 2021 COVID Vaccination



#### People Vaccinated by Locality of Residence and Vaccination Status - Percent of the Population









- 73% of unvaccinated adults trust their doctor's opinion about the Covid vaccine, but only 19% have received info from their doctors.






